# Best of Israel

## **Feb. 10 – Depart USA**

Today you will depart from the USA to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

## **Feb. 11 – Arrive Tel Aviv**

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and be transferred to your hotel in the Galilee area for check-in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

## **Feb. 12 – Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, Mount of Beatitudes, Tabgha, Boat Ride, Jordan River**

Drive along the shores of the **Sea of Galilee**, passing the area of Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene. Enter the 2,000 year old remains of **Capernaum** (Luke 4) and stand in what is left of the synagogue in which our Lord ministered. Visit the peaceful **Mount of Beatitudes** that overlooks the Sea of Galilee. On this hill, Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7). Stop at **Tabgha**, where the feeding of the 5,000 is remembered at the **Church of the Loaves and Fish** (Luke 9). Enjoy a **boat ride on the Sea of Galilee** and appreciate the special place this lake had in Jesus' ministry. End the day with a stop at the **Jordan River** for a time of spiritual blessing.

## **Feb. 13 – Northern Territory, Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Golan Heights**

Discover the Northern Territory, including Tel Dan, one of ancient Israel's boundary markers – "From Dan to Beersheba." Visit **Caesarea Philippi**, where Jesus traveled with His disciples and where nearby Peter made his great confession to Jesus, "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matt. 16:16). Travel through the **Golan Heights** and better understand their strategic importance to the security of Israel.

## **Feb. 14 – Nazareth Precipice, Megiddo, Mount Carmel, Caesarea by the Sea**

View the city of **Nazareth** from the vantage point where tradition states the local populace attempted to throw the Lord off a cliff. Travel the ancient caravan route to **Tel Megiddo**, an exciting archeological dig with its layers of twenty different cities built on top of each other. Look across the **Valley of Jezreel** to the heights of **Mount Carmel**, where Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Wander through the **Roman aqueduct** and theater at Caesarea, a center of early Christianity. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new covenant (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for trial (Acts 23). Continue to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

## **Feb. 15 – Valley of the Shadow, Masada, Qumran, Dead Sea**

Pass through the **Judean Wilderness** paralleling the ancient Roman road to view the **Valley of the Shadow**. From here, you can see St. George's Monastery across the gorge. Enjoy a visit to intriguing **Masada**, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod that later became the final tragic stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress and look down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Visit **Qumran**, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to learn about the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. On your return to Jerusalem, stop at the shores of the **Dead Sea**, the lowest spot on earth, for an opportunity to take a quick dip in the mineral-laden waters.

## **Feb. 16 – Mount of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Bethlehem, View Shepherds' Field**

Stand on the **Mount of Olives** for a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, and consider that this is the final place Jesus stood before ascending into heaven forty days after His resurrection (Acts 1). Enter the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Jesus went to pray after the Last Supper and was arrested (Matt. 26:36-56). Cross the border into **Bethlehem**, the birthplace of Jesus (Luke 2). Visit Bethlehem, where the cave revered as Jesus' birthplace resides in the world's oldest functioning church, the **Church of the Nativity** (Matt. 1). Look out on the **Shepherds' Fields**, where angels spread the Good News.

## **Feb. 17 – Caiaphas' House, Western Wall, Cardo, Old City Tour, Sister's of Zion Church, Pool of Bethesda, Church of the Holy Sepulcher**

Beneath the **Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu**, you can walk through some of the ancient rooms of the house belonging to **Caiaphas the High Priest**. Many believe that Jesus was held overnight here before His crucifixion (Luke 22). Touch a part of **Herod's Temple** as we pray at the **Western Wall**. Walk through the **Old City** and enjoy the preserved, ancient culture found in the narrow streets as well as the modernized **Cardo** in the Jewish Quarter. Visit the Lithostrotos at the Convent of the Sisters of Zion. This area of pavement constructed with large slabs is associated with the condemnation of Jesus by Pilate (John 19). View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Reflect on Christ's sacrificial love at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**.

## Itinerary Continued . . .

### Feb. 18 – Mount Zion, Upper Room, Pool of Siloam, Yad Vashem

Travel to **Mount Zion** and meditate on the events of the Last Supper as you visit the traditional location of the **Upper Room** (Mark 14). Stand on the steps of the **Pool of Siloam**, where Jesus healed the blind man (John 9). Walk the museum and grounds of **Yad Vashem**, Israel's Holocaust Memorial, with its poignant exhibits honoring the millions of lives lost during the Holocaust. At the end of your time in the Holy Land, prepare for your return journey to the USA.

### Feb. 19 – Arrive in the USA

Arrive in the USA with a lifetime of memories to cherish.
